Indulgenced Acts for the Poor Souls

A partial indulgence can be obtained by devoutly visiting the cemetery and praying for the departed souls. One can gain a plenary indulgence **visiting a cemetery any day between November 1 and November 8.** These indulgences are applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory.

A plenary indulgence is also granted when the faithful piously visit a church or a public oratory on **November 2, the Feast of All Souls.** In visiting the church or oratory, it is required, that one Our Father and the Creed be recited.
