

KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS NEWS BABY BOTTLE DRIVE

Who are the organizations we are supporting with this year's Baby Bottle Drive?

St. Mary's Home for Mothers is a maternal residence just outside of Liberty. MO, formed through the efforts of The Gabriel Project Mission KC. The facility houses up to 15 women and children. This ministry provides assistance to pregnant women in need. GPKC funds Respect Life initiatives for pregnant mothers in need throughout the greater metropolitan area. GPKC was helping pregnant women in so many ways, but got frustrated with the lack of housing resources for women struggling with homelessness. St. Mary's Home for Mothers is now its own agency but still partners with GPKC in many ways, such as monitoring of funding and utilizing the Angel Program.

Pastor's Corner

Gloria tibi Trinitas:

Gloria tibi Trinitas, Glory to you, Most Holy Trinity, is a prayer that was offered by St. Edith Stein throughout the day, because in it, she found the truth that explained all other truths. It is a prayer of thanksgiving, and recognition. The doctrine of the Holy Trinity is the most fundamental doctrine of our faith. Without it, everything else falls apart, not even the resurrection would make sense. At the same time, it seems to defy logic and be an impossible truth. How can God become man, while remaining God? If the Father and the Son are different, how can they be the same? How is it possible for the Father to know something that the Son does not know, but yet no one knows the Father except for the Son (and those He has revealed Him to)? Where did the idea of three person in One God come from? The number of seemingly paradoxical truths of the Holy Trinity is nearly endless, but at the same time, it is the foundation of our faith.

If Jesus, the Son was not God, then God was not raised from the dead, but something other and something less than God ascended into heaven, but it is not possible for anyone but God alone to have redeemed man; only the one who has been sinned against, who holds the debt is able to forgive the debt. This is why the law could not redeem man and why no man, no matter how virtuous and great he was, could win salvation. And if the Son was God, but not one with the Father, then there would be two gods. And when we begin thinking about the Holy Spirit, our faith would fall apart even more.

Through the pouring out of the Holy Spirit Christ fulfilled his promise "I will be with you even unto the end of the age." It is through the Holy Spirit, sent by the Father, that the Son remains with us. In the Holy Spirit, God the Father and the Son are both present. If not, then God would remain distant, you and I would be temples of a spirit that is not God, and there would be no real effect of the Sacraments: we would be eating, as had been called in the past, a death cookie, a cracker that would merely represent the life of a man who called himself the Son of God. It is the reality of the Holy Trinity, the consubstantial union of Father, Son and Holy Spirit that makes salvation possible, that makes the real presence of Christ possible and allows you to be a temple of the Holy Spirit.
